Sub:- Grant of Scholarship to Top 50 Candidates qualifying PGETA-2024 for admission into 1st year of Post Graduate programmes in Architecture approved by the Council for academic session 2024-2025 – reg.

Dear Sir/ Madam,

As you are aware, the Council of Architecture is conducting Post Graduate Entrance Test in Architecture (PGETA-2024) at national level on **July 28, 2024** and **August 04, 2024**, for admission to the Post Graduate programmes being imparted at the architectural institutions approved by the Council for the academic session 2024-2025.

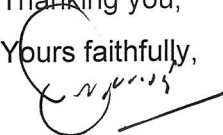
In this regard, I am pleased to inform you that the Council of Architecture has decided to grant scholarships to top 50 ranked candidates who qualify PGETA-2024 for taking admission into 1st year of Post Graduate programmes in Architecture approved by the Council at the architectural institutions in the country for the academic session 2024-2025. The scholarships will be granted by the Council as under:

1. Top 50 candidates qualifying PGETA-2024 for taking admission into 1st year of Post Graduate programmes in Architecture approved by Council shall be granted scholarship of Rs.50,000/-.
2. Eligible candidates shall receive a scholarship of Rs.25,000/- each year after passing First year and Final Year examination of the PG programme respectively.
3. The candidates shall be eligible to receive scholarship only if they have not received scholarship from any other authority for the said programme.
4. For release of scholarship to the candidates, the Head/Principal of the institution, after completion of First/Final year of the concerned candidate, is required to send a letter to Council certifying that the candidate has not received scholarship or any other aid from any other authority for the programme during the First/Final Year, enclosing therewith the programme marksheets(s).
5. A waiting list of 50 candidates ranking from 51 to 100 in PGETA-2024 shall be maintained by the Council. In case any of the Top 50 candidates leaves the programme or opt out of the scholarship due to any reason, candidates in the waiting list shall be considered for grant of scholarship in the order of their ranks.

In view of the above, the architectural institutions imparting Post Graduate programmes in Architecture approved by the Council are requested to kindly take note of the same and also provide wider publicity among the students and also in local newspapers/media, for the benefit and information of the aspiring students for the PG programme in Architecture.
